





Project Location

North San Mateo Drive (Peninsula Avenue to Baldwin Avenue)


- North-South bicycle corridor






Class II bicycle lane implementation – physical characteristics

EXISTING

Poplar Ave to Peninsula Ave

- 4-lane configuration
- 2 travel lanes in each directions





PROPOSED

Poplar Ave to Peninsula Ave

- 3-lane configuration
- 1 travel lane in each direction
- 2-way left turn lane
- Class II bicycle lanes


